

PANMECTINE 10

INJECTABLE SOLUTION

Composition:

Each ml solution contains:
10 mg ivermectine

Spectrum of activity:

Ivermectine inactivates parasitic nematodes, arachnids, and insects. Its action on the nematodes is by inhibiting signal transmission from the ventral cord interneurons to the excitatory motor neurons. At therapeutic doses, ivermectine has no effect on mammals since their GABA systems are confined in the central nervous system into which ivermectine does not penetrate readily. Ivermectine is unrelated structurally to any of the presently available parasiticides. Because of this and its unique mode of action not shared by any other antiparasitic agent, cross resistance does not occur.

Indications:

Panmectine 10 is indicated for the treatment and control of gastro-intestinal nematodes, lungworms, and external parasites in cattle, pigs, sheep and goats and camels.

Dosage and administration:

For subcutaneous injection.
The general dose is 1 ml/ 50 kg bodyweight.
Cattle, sheep, goats and camels: 1 ml per 50 kg bodyweight
Pigs: 1 ml per 33 kg bodyweight

Withdrawal time:

For meat: 28 days.
Product is not recommended for use in animals producing milk for human consumption. Not to be used in pregnant animals in the last month of their gestation.

Storage:

Store closed, protected from light and below 25 °C. Do not refrigerate and/ or freeze.

Shelf life:

3 years.

Presentation:

Plastic vial of 50 ml, 100ml and 250ml.
